She is a former trustee and president of the Vermont Historical Society and co-chair of its multi-million-dollar capital campaign, as well as serving as a commissioner for the Vermont Statehood Bicentennial. She was a consultant to the founding board and advisory trustee for the Decorative Arts Center of Ohio. She currently serves as a director of the Community National Bank, headquartered in Derby, and as a trustee of the American College of Greece in Athens. She was recently appointed by Gov. James Douglas to the University of Vermont–Vermont State Colleges Task Force, which is charged with determining whether academic and/or administrative efficiencies could be gained through changes to Vermont’s system of public higher education.
